FACILITY

McBride Stadium, located close to the campus of Earlham College on NW 13th street. Built in the mid-1930's with seating for 2,000, McBride has been home to many minor league teams most recently the Richmond Roosters of the Frontier League. The facility includes a full size diamond, team clubhouses, concession stands, media press box, 6 bull pen mounds, drill areas and multiple batting cages.

The camp is open to players who will be graduating from High School in 2011 or 2012 and who have a strong desire to play college baseball. The camp has a limited enrollment so sign up early. CAMP STAFF

Steve Sakosits is in his 1st year as head baseball coach at Earlham College. For the past two years, Sakosits has been the Associate Head baseball coach at Earlham. Previously, at Defiance College he was the pitching/outfield coach. At Defiance, Coach Sakosits coached 9 All-HCAC performers including the 2007 HCAC Freshman of the Year.

Sakosits graduated from Division I Xavier University where he was a four-year starter in the outfield and on the mound. At Xavier, he was team captain and is in the record books in several statistical categories. He has worked as an instructor/coach at many baseball camps including TPX Top 96, New Jersey Colts, Xavier University, Dayton University, University of Cincinnati, The Baseball Factory, and The All-American Baseball Academy.
