ABOUT THE CAMP

The Earlham College Prospect Camp is for players who will be graduating from high school in 2010 or 2011. The camp is designed to allow players to develop their skills in both instructional and game settings while also being able to showcase their talent.

Prospects will be evaluated in the following areas: Hitting, fielding and running. All prospects will be able to attend instructional sessions on pitching, catching, fielding and hitting. In addition, all prospects will participate in a scrimmage.

FACILITY

The \$13-million Athletics and Wellness Center opened at the beginning of the Fall 1999 semester. Admission for students is free. The facility features an energy center for cardiovascular and strength training, a group fitness studio for aerobics and yoga, Weber Pool (25 meters by six lanes), racquetball courts, tennis courts, a running track, a climbing wall and Schuckman Court (a performance gymnasium with seating for 1,800). The building is also equipped with offices and classrooms. Baseball as well uses the four-court multipurpose gymnasium with the ability to take a full infield, two drop down batting tunnels and turf pitching mounds.

COST

Cost for the camp is \$35 if you pre-register (\$50 walk-up or after January 11). The fee includes a camp T-shirt, quality instruction and evaluation. GENERAL INFORMATION

The camp is open to players who will be graduating from High School in 2010 or 2011 and who have a strong desire to play college baseball. The camp has a limited enrollment so sign up early. Don't miss out on the opportunity to improve your game and learn more about what it takes to play baseball at the college level.

CAMP STAFF

John Cate, a member of the Indiana Baseball Coaches Hall-of-Fame, begins his 2nd season with the Earlham College baseball program.

Recently, Cate was in charge of the Richmond High School baseball program. That marked Cate's second stint as the head coach for RHS initially serving in that capacity from 1986-1995. Cate also has coached at Wes-Del, Belmont and Connersville high schools in Indiana.

At the high school level, Cate posted a 445-166 record including two appearances in the Final Four with Richmond in 1993 and 1995. During his career his teams won 12 sectionals, nine regionals and two semi-states. John Cate also has many professional baseball ties. He has been an associate scout with the Seattle Mariners and in 1995, Cate was the driving force in bringing professional baseball back to Richmond and McBride Stadium after nearly 40 years.

The Richmond Roosters played for 11 summers in the Frontier League with Cate wearing numerous hats as an investor, minority owner, director of baseball operations and field manager. Richmond is the only team in league history to win back-to-back championships when the Roosters won in 2001-02. Cate's five-year record as a manager with the Roosters was 165-151.

Steve Sakosits is in his 2nd year as pitching coach/recruiting coordinator at Earlham College. Previously, Sakosits was at Defiance College where he was the pitching/outfield coach. At Defiance, Coach Sakosits coached 9 All-HCAC performers including the 2007 HCAC Freshman of the Year.

Sakosits graduated from Division I Xavier University where he was a four-year starter in the outfield and on the mound. At Xavier, he was team captain and is in the record books in several statistical categories. He has worked as an instructor/coach at many baseball camps including TPX Top 96, New Jersey Colts, Xavier University, Dayton University, University of Cincinnati, The Baseball Factory, and The All-American Baseball Academy.

Other camps staff may include several other area High School or College Coaches. In addition, several of our current players will also participate in the camp
