



# EARLHAM COLLEGE ATHLETICS UPDATE



## Coming This Week:

- **Cross Country:** The Quakers begin the season at the Franklin Invitational on Saturday. The meet begins at 10 a.m.
- **Field Hockey:** Earlham (0-1) makes a trip to Pennsylvania this weekend. On Saturday, the Quakers face St. Vincent College in Latrobe at 11 a.m. The Quakers play Wells College on Sunday at St. Vincent. That match also begins at 11 a.m.
- **Football:** The Quakers open the season in Darrell Beane Stadium as the Rose-Hulman Engineers visit Richmond. The non-conference contest gets underway at 1 p.m.
- **Men's Soccer:** The annual El Rodeo Classic is on tap this weekend for the Quakers (0-1). Earlham faces Adrian College Friday on Matlack Field at 6 p.m. On Saturday, the Quakers meet Lawrence University at 3 p.m.
- **Volleyball:** Earlham (0-1) welcomes five teams to Richmond this weekend for the EC Quaker Classic. The Quakers begin the two-day affair on Friday against Principia on Schuckman Court in the Athletics and Wellness Center at 5 p.m. Earlham faces the University of the Columbians on Friday at 9 p.m. Saturday, the Quakers will play two more matches, but the opponents will be determined by Friday's results. The other teams coming to the event are Rose-Hulman, Goshen College and Marian College.
- **Women's Soccer:** The Quakers (1-0) host the annual El Rodeo Classic this weekend on Matlack Field. On Friday, Earlham plays Adrian College at 4 p.m. The Quakers face Lawrence University Saturday at 1 p.m.

## And From Last Week:

- **Field Hockey:** The Earlham College field hockey team opened the season on Tuesday with a 3-0 loss to Ohio Wesleyan University in a North Coast Athletic Conference contest on Comstock Field. The Bishops (1-0, 1-0) scored once in the first half and finished with a pair of goals in the second period. Ohio Wesleyan had a 13-4 advantage in shots and an 11-5 edge in corners. Earlham goalkeeper Emma Treece had four saves for the Quakers.
- **Men's Soccer:** The Earlham College men's soccer team surrendered a goal in the second half Tuesday as the Quakers fell 1-0 to the Rose-Hulman Institute of Technology on Matlack Field. The Engineers scored at the 69:13 mark to take the lead in the season opener for both teams. Rose-Hulman had an 8-7 edge in shots with a 4-3 margin in corner kicks. Earlham goalkeeper Jonah Kresiske had four saves for the Quakers.
- **Volleyball:** The Earlham College volleyball team opened the season on Tuesday with a 26-24, 23-25, 25-18, 25-22 loss to Franklin College on Schuckman Court in the Athletics and Wellness Center. Keeley McAnnis-Entenman led the Quakers with 11 kills, while Andrea Thompson added six. Ramona Hemmings, Nikki Darrett and Elizabeth Ross added four each. Alicia Kees topped the Quakers with 26 assists, while Darrett led the way with 13 digs. McAnnis-Entenman finished with 12 digs and four blocks. Ross added nine digs and four blocks. Thompson had seven service aces to lead Earlham, with Ross contributing five.
- **Women's Soccer:** A pair of second half goals was all the Earlham College women's soccer team needed Tuesday as the Quakers posted a 2-0 victory over the Rose-Hulman Institute of Technology on Matlack Field. JoBeth Buckley got the Quakers on the scoreboard first in the season opener with an unassisted goal at 68:27, while Cate Simmermaker added the second score at 72:45. Ikumi Doucette added the assist on the final goal. Earlham had a 15-8 advantage in shots, while edging the Engineers (0-1) in corner kicks 5-3. Megan Holthaus had three saves in goal for the Quakers.
